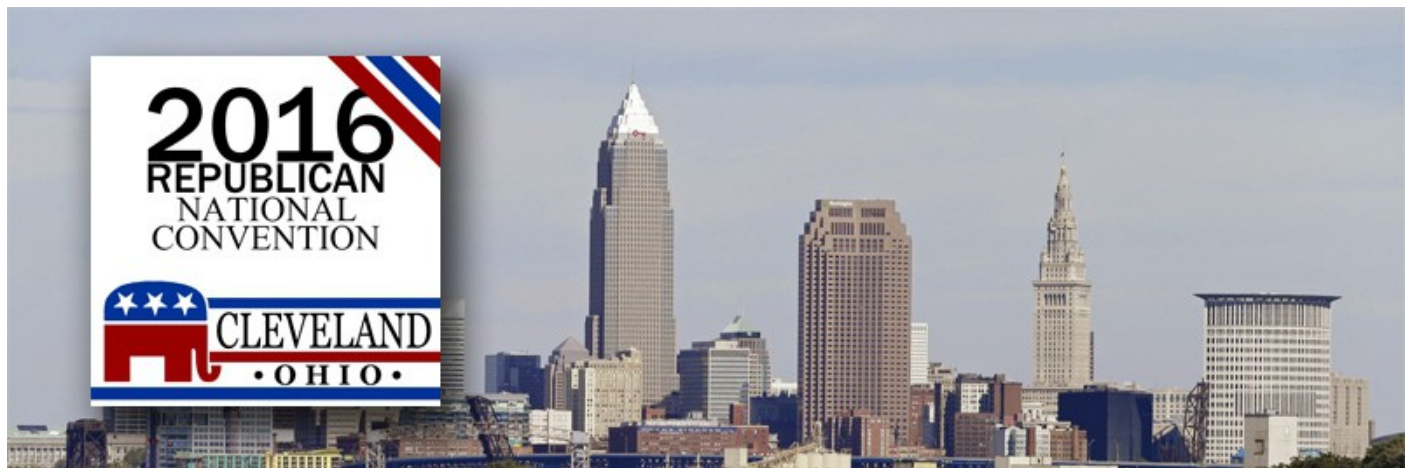


Rob Secaur, Ohio Victory Director for the RNC, gave an update. May 21st will be our next Day of Action. More details will be coming.
