Further, Robert Scott shall act as the second alternate elector and serve in such elector's place, followed by Robert Secaur if there is a third vacancy, **Stephanie Garrett** if there is a fourth vacancy, and Ranae Lentz if there is a fifth vacancy. If other vacancies occur in the above electors, their positions shall be replaced by a member of the Ohio Republican State Central and Executive Committee, according to seniority.
